- b) Village Treasurer M. Ferrell Treasurer Ferrell provided the board with the current state of the village's general fund account as follows. The General Ledger balance of the Village's financial status is \$351,929.45. This amount includes the balance of Property Taxes of \$59,635.68. Excluding the American Rescue Plan Act Relief Grant of \$24,542.91.





The revenue budget for the month of November is \$128,824.00. The balance of expected Revenue budgeted for the month of November is \$67,478.00
